Attention: To insure proper use of your Wesco Kickout, read and follow these instructions before using.

The Wesco Kickout Option is designed exclusively for use with Wesco power appliance trucks. The Kickout Option Kit converts the appliance truck to a four-wheel truck for ease of handling with heavy loads.

Unpacking

When unpacking your Kickout Option Kit, check carefully for shipping damage and missing parts. If damage has occurred or any parts are missing, file a claim with the delivering carrier within 24 hours and notify the dealer from whom the set was purchased.

General Safety Information

Warning: The Wesco Kickout is intended for specific functions. Please adhere to the following instructions to insure proper use.

- (1) Maximum capacity: limited to that of the truck on which they are installed.
- (2) The Wesco Kickout is designed exclusively for use with Wesco power appliance trucks to assist in the transport of heavy loads.
- (3) Do not install or attempt to install the Kickout option on any trucks other than Wesco power appliance trucks.
- (4) Periodically, inspect the Kickout assembly for damage, wear, and loose hardware. If required, remove from service and repair.
- (5) Use only genuine Wesco replacement parts when servicing.

For Warranty Repairs

- (1) If the unit does not work properly, contact your dealer or the factory (215-699-7031) for units less than ninety days old.

For Non-Warranty Service:

- (1) For units older than ninety days, repairs can be made easily on site with factory supplied parts. **NOTE:** *Do not send units to the factory for service without obtaining a "returned goods authorization number" from the customer service department. We will not be responsible for goods returned without proper authorization.*

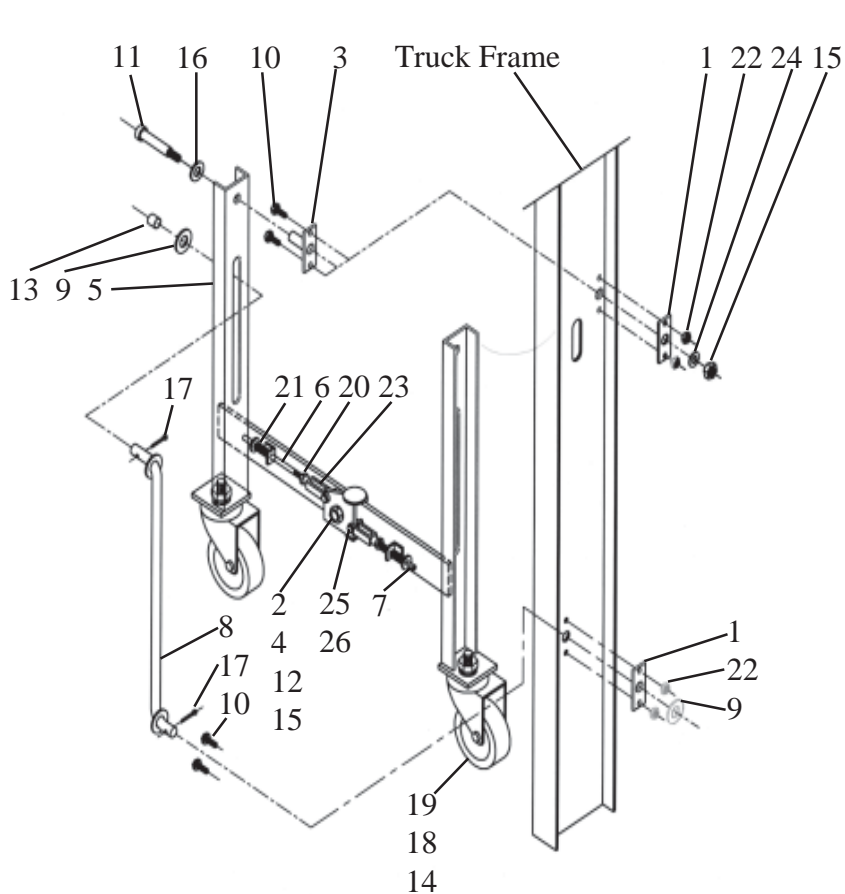

Depart-

Assembly

- 1) Assemble (4) upper reinforcement plates, one inside (item 1) and one outside (item 3) on each side of frame. Align center of 1/2" dia center holes before tightening 1/4-20 screws (item 10) and locknuts (item 22).
- 2) Assemble (2) lower reinforcement plates (item 1), on inside of each side of frame. Align center of 9/16" dia holes with frame before tightening 1/4-20 screws (item 10) and locknuts (item 22).
- 3) Assemble kickout (item 5) to frame with kickout crossbar away from frame and top pivot hole aligned with upper reinforcement plate. secure with 1/2 dia shoulder screw (item 11, washer (item 16), washer (item 24), nut (item 15)
- 4) With kickout in the open position, spread supports (item 8) to clear frame and insert ends into lower reinforcement plates. Secure with washer (item 9) and cotter pin (item 17) on inside of frame. Cover ends of rods with cap (item 13).
- 5) Test operation by lowering kickout (pull up supports by black knobs on outside ends), lock kick out to
